- Take the AZ-153 S towards 1-10/AZ-143.
- Turn SLIGHT LEFT onto EAST UNIVERSITY DR.
- Turn RIGHT onto AZ-143 S/HOHOKAM EXPWY.
- AZ-143 S turns into 48th ST.
- Take 48th St. to BASELINE RD.
- Turn LEFT onto BASELINE RD.
- Drive 2 blocks.
- Turn RIGHT onto S. Arizona Grand Parkway.
